## Salvador Dali (after)

A catalytic figure of twentieth-century art, Salvador Dalí (1904–1989) fused virtuoso technique with vaulting theatricality to help define Surrealism’s public image. From the late 1920s onward he cultivated a total artwork—paintings, sculpture, film, performance, and persona—through which desire and dream life were rendered with unnerving clarity. Dalí’s career unfolded across Europe and the United States, yet he remained tethered to Catalonia, where the Dalí Theatre-Museum later enshrined

his vision. Institutions today steward a vast record of his practice, spanning over two thousand works and extensive archives. His legacy endures in both scholarship and popular culture: museums continue to reinterpret his oeuvre for new audiences, while recent publications and exhibitions revisit the contradictions that powered his lifelong performance of art and self.
