A Cool Collectible Design Showcase Arrives in New York

For homebound Manhattanites looking for a change of scenery, Galerie Philia is opening up a special showcase in Chelsea's Walker Tower, a striking 1929 Art Deco building, this Monday. In a duplex apartment on the 18th floor of the Ralph Walker-designed structure, the international gallery will be showing an exciting curation of more than 70 collectible designs by 40 global talents. Italian architect and designer Pietro Franceschini, who co-curated the setup, says to AD PRO: "The goal was to put together a scenario between a gallery and a real, livable apartment. We wanted the objects and artworks to have enough space to express themselves but at the same time be in constant communication with each other."
