

Mexico offers a wide range of art events that you can attend to meet both established artists and emerging spirits that are beginning to draw attention to the contemporary scene in our country. Today we bring you three events you won't want to miss during ART WEEK 2022 in Mexico City.



## TRANSATLÁNTICO (TRANSATLANTIC)

"Transatlántico brings together the best food, aural, visual and aromatic experience under the same roof, transforming the space into a memorable moment of art week, Zona Maco."

Latin America and Europe come together behind the doors of Galerie Philia, which between now and February 12 will present TRANSATLÁNTICO, an exhibition that unites creators from Mexico, Argentina, Colombia, Puerto Rico and the Dominican Republic with European designers to blur the social, political and geographical borders of two continents.

Cristián Mohaded explores carpentry with native woods from Argentina, while Estudio Breuer demonstrates its mastery with its *geomuebles* (geofurniture); Verdi Design stands out with La Macorina, a sculpture of 4,000 handmade knots, or the geometric lamps of Manu Bañó. VIDIVIXI, Caralarga, Estudio Raffreyre, Lla Ceramics, Estudio Chuch and Rodrigo Bravo are just some of the other names featured in the event, accompanying European artists such as Vladimir Naumov, Pietro Franceschini, Alex de Witte, Mark Sturkenboom or Rick Owens.

TRANSATLÁNTICO's immersive space was made in collaboration with the luxury events company House of Kirschner, renowned for its avant-garde installations.
